TOPIC:

Groundwater Resources on Delmarva: Sustainable Management or Long-term Water Mining?

Regulations require, and policy-makers intend, to manage groundwater resources for sustainability in the long-term. While the available groundwater resources remain plentiful at present, a growing body of data suggests that in some locations, groundwater withdrawals already are occurring at rates not truly sustainable. This presentation will review the hydrogeological and regulatory settings of several select areas on and near the Delmarva Peninsula where withdrawals are occurring at rates which appear not sustainable, and will offer some recommendations for the future.
